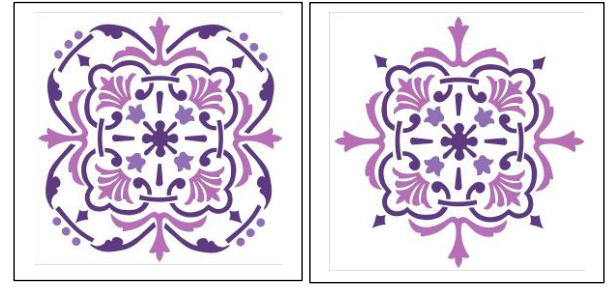

## Added Dimensions-Hand: The Crowns-Crown/Tiara

## Supply list:

**Required: Order items by February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

- **Hand Accessory Kit 1 or 2** (Each student needs to select one of these kits, useable for both classes.) cost= \$29.08/ \$21.39 respectively.

Kit 1 = 1 – pack No 7 sharps needle

Kit 2 = 1 – No 7 sharps needle

Kit 1 = 1 – pack No. 11 Milliner's Needle

Kit 2 = 1 – No. 11 Milliner's Needle

Kit 1 & 2 = 1 – spool Neutral or White Basting thread

Kit 1 & 2 = 1 - pair small, sharp 4" Kai bent-handled, slightly blunt-tipped scissors

**A word about fabrics:** Batiks are required. Pre-washing is recommended.

In our sample White is the top fabric and is reverse appliquéd onto the Dark purple background. When using a light top over a dark background sometimes the light fabric is changed. Just make sure you like the look of the fabric placed on top of the darker background fabric. The Orchid colored design elements, the Purple tulips and dots are appliquéd on top of the White top fabric. You do not need to choose the same colors as we did in our sample, but use this color information as a guide in selecting your own color palette. Whatever colors you choose, we request you choose batiks or top quality, tight weave hand-dyes for this project. If advanced, try working in silk, wool or mixing your fibers.

**Fabric Requirements:** This yardage is enough to make two blocks finished as a pillow, candle mat or as a wall-hanging.

- ½ yard - Top fabric (**White**)
- 1 1/8 yard - Background fabric (**Dark Purple**)
- 3/8 yard - for applique of tulips and dots (**Medium Purple**)
- ½ yard - for applique of design elements (**Orchid Purple**)

1 Spool of 60, 80 wt. or silk thread for stitching (SAME COLORS as top, middle and accent batiks)

No 7 sharps needle-(included in Hand Accessory kit)

No. 11 Milliner's Needle- (included in Hand Accessory kit)

Hand cotton quilting/ button thread for Basting (CONTRAST COLOR to top, middle and accent batiks) (included in Hand Accessory kit)

1 pair Kai 4" bent-handled slightly blunt-tipped scissors (included in Hand Accessory kit)

5 – 8 safety pins for pin basting, and 5-8 straight pins

Light box (to trace design onto wrong side of background batik)



Marking implements: Mechanical pencil, white pencil &/or Frixion gel pen for tracing pattern onto wrong side of background batik

Optional Machine Basting: Sewing machine, 90/14 needle, open-toed foot, 40 wt. thread (CONTRAST COLOR to top fabrics).

Helpful items: Needle threader for small-eyed needles; Beam N' Read personal light.



## Preparation BEFORE class for The Crowns-Crown/Tiara

**Required:** *The Crown-Crown/Tiara* pattern

1. Read the pattern through paying special attention to the directions for *Hand Reverse Applique* and *Hand Applique*.

2. Then read again cutting the fabric.

Cut the fabric and bring to class:

- 1 – 17 ½" x 17 ½" square, Top fabric (**White**)
- 1 - 17 ½" x 17 ½" square, Background fabric (**Dark Purple**)
- 1 – 6" x 8" rectangle, applique of tulips and dots (**Medium Purple**)
- 1 – 16" x 16" square, applique of design elements (**Orchid Purple**)

3. Read and follow the directions for *Hand Reverse Applique Trace*, 1, 2, 3 and 4. If comfortable, you could begin to *Baste* 1 and 2 the reverse applique.
